The specific research directions of the SciNetNatHazPrev project were presented as follow:

- 1) Earthquake hazard. National legislation and practices. Prof. Dimo Solokov Inst. of Seismology, Bulgarian Academy of Sciences
- 2) Landslide hazard. Review of the existing methodologies in landslide risk assessment and management. Results obtained in the implementation of the project Prof. Nikolay Dobrev/ Assoc. Prof. Plamen Ivanov Inst. of Geology, Bulgarian Academy of Sciences
- 3) Flooding hazard. Methods for estimation of flooding events. Data sources and application of GIS. Case study for "Chengne skele" Burgas Assoc. Prof. Georgi Zhelezov/ Assoc. Prof. Boyko Berov National Institute of Geophysics, Geodesy and Geography, Bulgarian Academy of Sciences

The event finished with open discussion which was rich in comments and suggestions from the side of participants.
