The stakeholder's meeting is organized within the context of the project "A Scientific Network for Earthquake, Landslide and Flood Hazard prevention-SciNetNatHaz", which is co-funded by the European Union (ENPI and IPA) and National funds, through the Black Sea Basin Joint Operational Programme 2007-13.

The project aims at Earthquake, Landslide and Flood disaster mitigation through preventive actions based on informed decisions. More than 80 scientists and experts coming from six different countries around the Black Sea were brought together sharing competencies and cooperating within this project, which was awarded by the Joint Managing Authority as a "Best Practice" project (May 2014).

During the Final Meeting, the project outputs including proposals for harmonized Earthquake, Landslide and Flood Hazard Prevention activities will be presented to stakeholders, along with the results of pilot implementations carried out in various areas around the Black Sea coast.
